### Pastor's Ponderings......

### Say "Yes"

But the angel said to Mary, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; his kingdom will never end."

"How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?"

The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.

"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Then the angel left her. - Luke 1: 30-35, 38

At the recent Heartland Conference Annual Gathering, keynote preacher Rev. Dr. Imani Jones spoke to the gathering about the power of saying 'Yes' to God. Using this text, Rev. Dr. Jones pointed out how frightening it must have been to Mary to see the angel. And then how much more frightening it must have been to hear God's plan as the angel set it out!

Mary was a young girl, maybe 14-16, and she was going to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. What must have gone through her head? "How do I tell my parents?" "How do I break this to Joseph?" "What will the people of my village say when they find out I'm pregnant? Will anybody believe me?"

We take it for granted that of course Mary would say 'Yes' to God. But she was a real person, with real fears about what a pregnancy might mean for her, quite apart from the responsibility of being the mother of someone who would be called 'the Son of God.' That would freak anybody out all on its own.

But, in spite of all her fears, Mary said 'Yes.' Everything in Christian faith begins with this 'Yes.' Jesus was born when and where he was, because Mary said 'Yes' to God. All the power and the glory, all the healing, teaching, forgiving, reconciling, and resurrecting of Jesus comes from that 'Yes.'

So what would it mean for you to say 'Yes' to God this year as we go through the church season of Advent? What would God ask you to do? What would frighten you about saying 'Yes', and would you say it anyway, as Mary did? What could God accomplish through you, if only you would say 'Yes'?

### **FACILITIES**

**OUTSIDE, INSIDE AND ALL AROUND** - The parking lot is in need of repair and estimates are being sought, in hopes of having this project completed before bad weather season.

Estimates for light conversion to LED, in the parlor and the narthex, are being pursued. This will almost complete the conversion to LED throughout the church.

We want to thank those members who have contributed to the air conditioner fund. At this time, we have received over \$10,000 toward the \$14,000 cost. If you have not yet contributed, please consider doing so.

CHURCH RENTAL HOUSE AVAILABLE – We currently have a 2-bedroom unit available in the church's rental house on Arlington Ave.

The unit consists of an eat-in kitchen, with dining and living rooms on the lower level. The upstairs has 2 bedrooms and 1 full bathroom. The unit comes with a stove, refrigerator, dishwasher, washer and dryer, 1 parking space in the garage, and two additional parking spaces. There is no central air-conditioning, but the unit can accommodate window units. The monthly rent is \$850.00 and will require a credit and background check, signing a 1-year lease and providing an \$850.00 security deposit. Tenant will be responsible for paying their own gas, electric, cable and internet. Water and sewer charges are taken care of by the church.

Showings for the unit can be scheduled through the church office, starting November 1st. Thank you!

### SPIRITUAL LIFE

BRINGING BACK FELLOWSHIP HOUR - Now that we've had inchurch services for a few months, it's time to talk about bringing back Fellowship Hour! For those of you who have been to a service, you know that everyone is already congregating (masked!) in the narthex and hallways, for a while afterwards. To acknowledge this, we will be opening up Pilgrim Hall for Fellowship Hour according to the following schedule:

**November 2021**: Pilgrim Hall will be available for BYO snack/beverage gatherings, on Sundays after the service. There will not be people scheduled for set up, serving, snacks or cleanup, so we will count on those who gather to clean up after themselves.

**December 2021 and Beyond**: We will add the roles of "Setup/Servers," "Snacks" and "Cleanup," to the Breeze Participant Sign-up Sheets, for services starting in December. Assuming that we have volunteers, we will work our way toward re-establishing a more "normal" Fellowship Hour for all.

We will request that those who are not vaccinated continue to wear masks while in Fellowship Hall. For those that are fully vaccinated masks will be optional.
